I want to pay it forward and I am asking you to do the same. Will you please support NMC students?

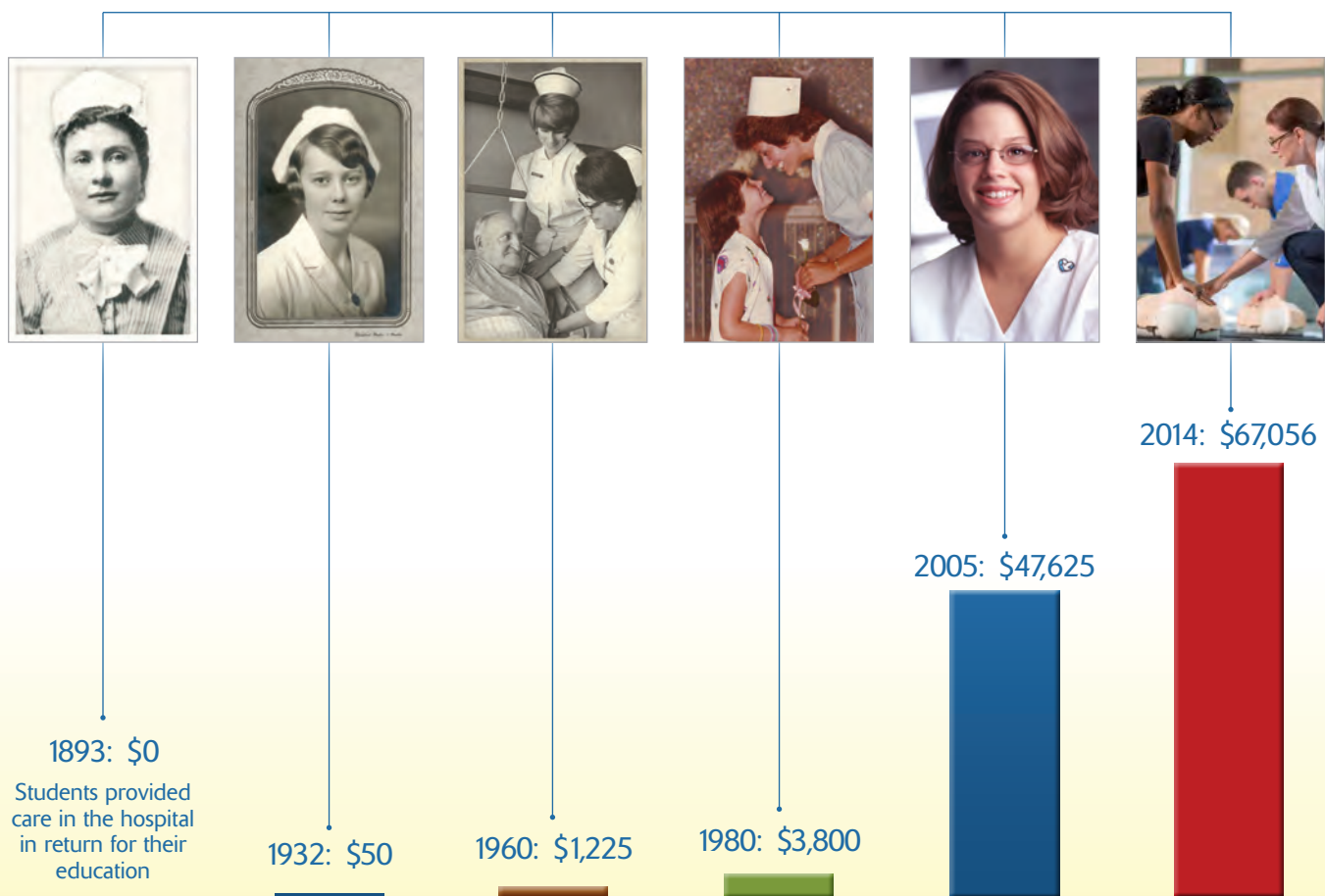
